MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION FORM

Membership is open to Brough owners, riders and anyone interested in Broughs. Applications should be sent to the Membership Secretary, together with the first annual subscription, entry fee and the postage supplement, if applicable. An information pack is sent to acknowledge receipt of subscriptions and the first Newsletter will follow. Family members are welcome for a small extra fee.

The monthly Newsletter is published both in paper form and available on-line for a reduced Membership fee. It contains technical, historical and other articles, details of Club events, other news and advertisements (for sale and wanted). Advertisements can be placed in the Newsletter free of charge to Members. The Editor always welcomes hints such as ‘Where to get it done’ and ‘Where to buy’ for publication.

The Club’s main event is the Annual Rally held during August. Local rallies and social meetings are held throughout the year at various places. The Club is run by a committee, appointed at the A.G.M.

A Spares Scheme, operated by the associated company Brough Superior Club (Spares and Events) Ltd., is in operation for most cycle parts and castings and spares for JAP and Matchless engines. The Club has a large range of Miscellaneous items. Up-to-date lists are available from, Mike Smith, at the same company. The current list is supplied in the welcome pack sent to new members. The full list, including any new items, is published in the Club Newsletter on a regular basis.

The Club operates a loan scheme for Members who have been in the Club for a year or over. It allows approved applicants to borrow the Tate Brough—a 1937 MX80—for two months or more. The charges made are for maintenance and to contribute to insurance cover. The bike can only be ridden within the United Kingdom.. Details of how to apply can be obtained from two committee members, Howard Wilcox and Terry Hobden.

A copy of the original works record card for the majority of Broughs built is available to members for a small fee and by sending a stamped, addressed envelope. Please quote frame, engine and registration numbers and apply to the Machine Registrar.
